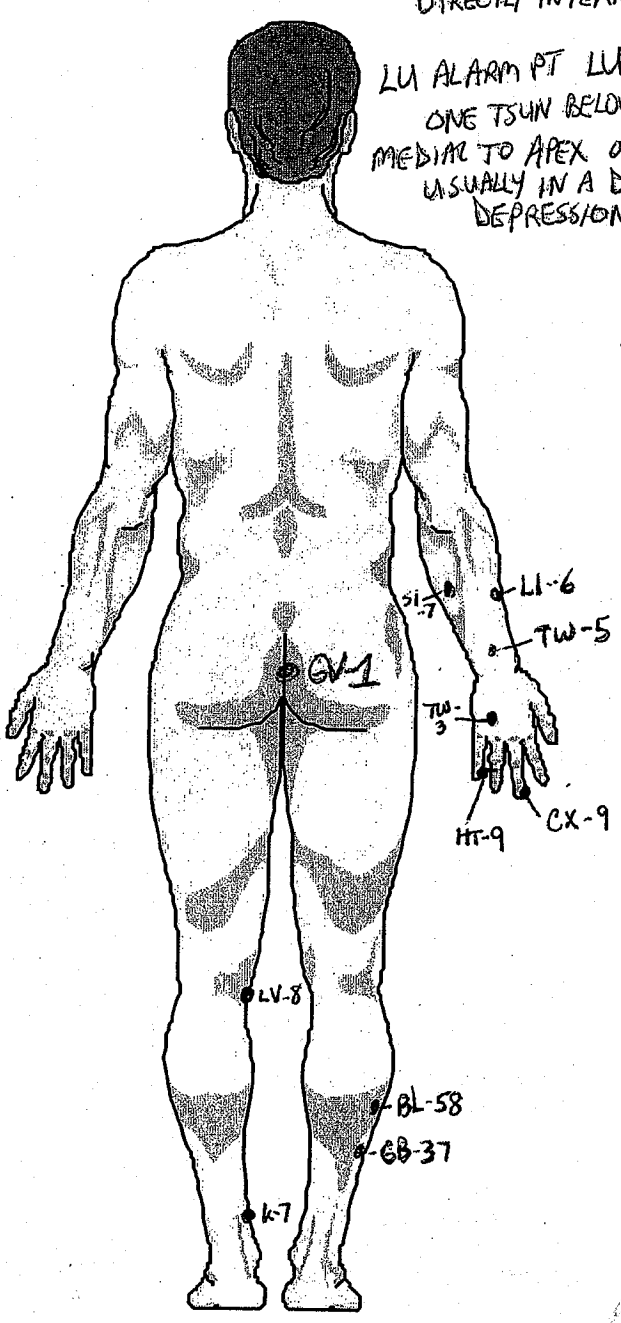
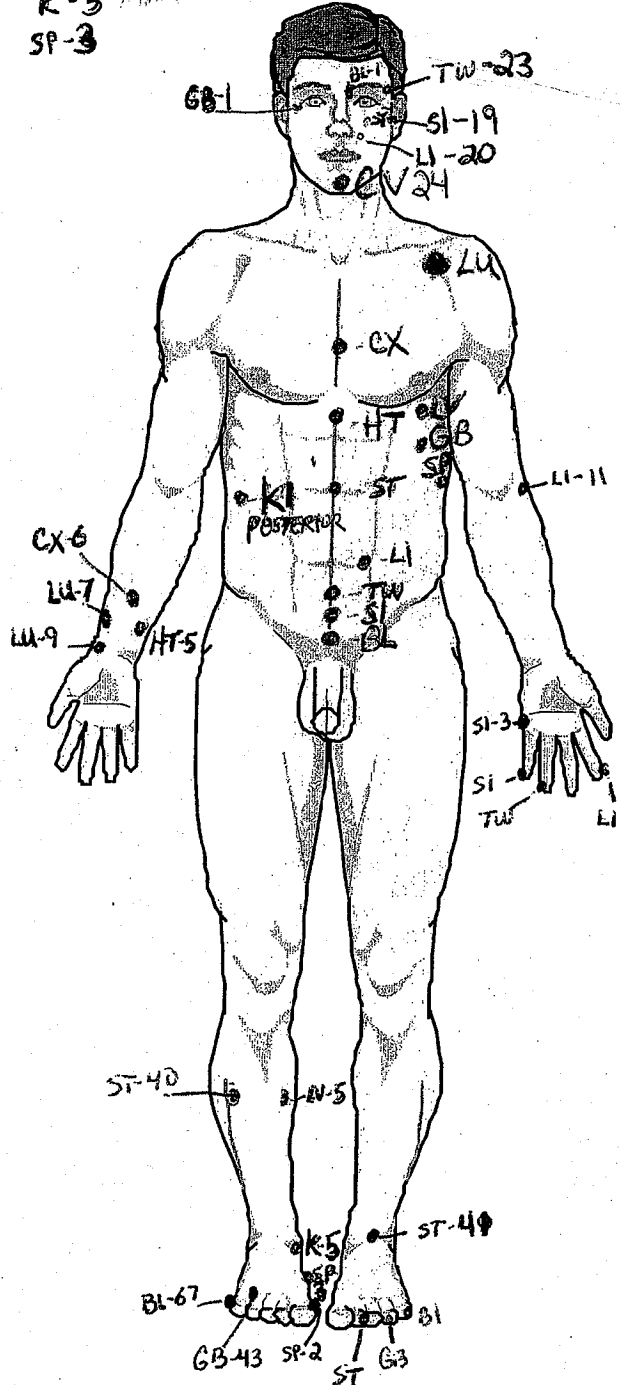

 TW ALARM POINT CV-5 (ONE TSUN ABOVE CV-4) 1/2 BETWEEN UMBILICUS CV-8 + PUBIC SYMPHYSIS CV-2  
 ST ALARM POINT CV-12 (HALFWAY BETWEEN CV-8 (UMBILICUS) + CV-15 (TIP OF XIPHOID PROCESS))  
 HT ALARM POINT CV-14 (ONE TSUN BELOW TIP OF XIPHOID BONE)  
 CX ALARM POINT CV-17 (2 TSUN ABOVE INFERIOR TIP OF XIPHOID PROCESS)  
 LI ALARM POINT ST-25 (ONE AND A HALF TSUN LATERAL TO UMBILICUS)
